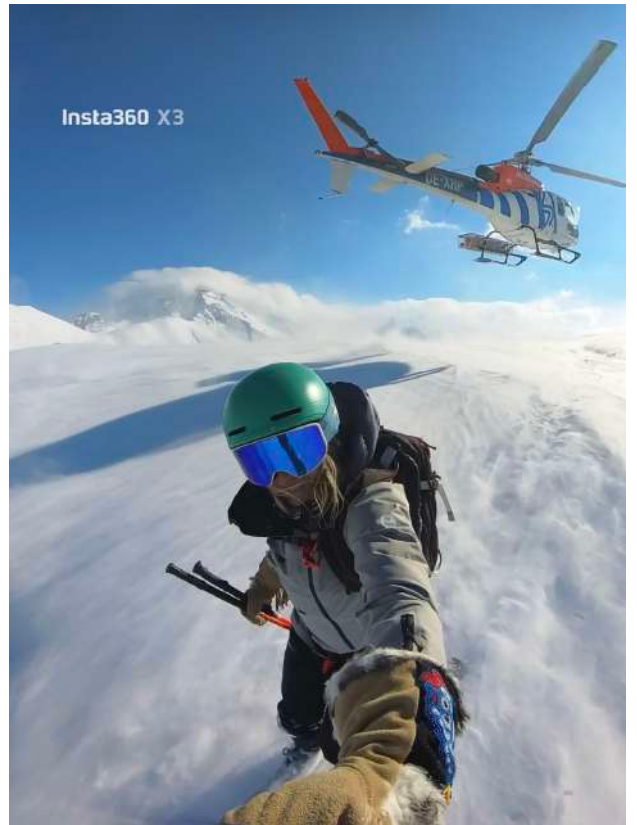






WHAT INCLUDES

WHAT TO EXPECT

ARRIVAL DAY

Our programs begin the evening of the arrival day. Arrival in Akureyri, Iceland in the evening, followed by a 45 min transfer to Klængshóll Lodge for a meet and greet, guest briefing and dinner. On the first evening you will have the chance to discuss with your guide, make sure all your gear is in order and relax after your travels.

DAY 1

We begin the 1st morning of skiing reviewing avalanche and helicopter safety protocols. After the group is briefed on these important safety issues we are ready to get out for a great day of skiing, adventure and exploration.

DAY 2|3 OR 2|5

Our guides set the pace and rhythm of the program so that everyone enjoys it to the fullest. After each day of skiing we will relax and enjoy Klængshóll Lodge lounging in the hot tub, relaxing in the sauna or having a great massage, followed by one delicious meal after another feasting on organic lamb, fish and game prepared by our very talented chef.

DAY 4 OR 6

This is the last day of skiing and the departure day for our guests. After a good breakfast and sorting our luggage we hop in the heli and head out for our final day. We will enjoy more great turns and good times followed by lunch in the field, and head home for one last sauna or hot tub session. After saying our goodbyes to our new friends in Ski Valley we transfer the group back to Akureyri where guests can catch a flight to Reykjavik or continue their travels in Iceland.





If you are looking to mix a little heli time with ski touring then you have come to the right place



The "Heli Assisted Ski Touring programs" include 60-90 minutes of flight time for helicopter transfers. We will start each morning with a helicopter transfer to the top of a peak. Warm up with a long descent before you start touring up for a 2nd descent or move on to a nearby summit. This is a great way to explore the Troll Peninsula allowing you to go a little further into the terrain.

There is also the possibility of going Ski touring without Heli. This programme is totally organized depending on the client wishes and level.



At Arctic Heli Skiing we understand the importance of getting a comfortable place to lay your head at night after a long day of skiing or riding. From an ancient sheep farm to an exclusive hotel we offer 3 different locations in Iceland to suit your group's needs. Klængshóll is our main base of operations and is used for our programmes, although we can offer Hotel Hjalteyri if this is the selection there will be another final price. Each location has its own unique character and we have made sure to take care of all the fine details to make sure your stay is as comfortable as possible. Each location is equipped with dining facilities, a hot tub, a helicopter landing area, and high speed internet.

KLÆNGSHÓLL | RAVEN HILL LODGE

Translate to in English, is our main base of operations and ancestral home. The Lodge is an ancient sheep farm that's been continually habited from the time of the settlement of the Vikings in Iceland in circa 850AD. The last sheep farmers at Klængshóll were the grandparents of Arctic Heli Skiing's founder Jökull Bergmann, and he grew up on the farm working as a shepherd in the mountains of the Troll Peninsula.

The Klængshóll property consists of 4 cabins, the main farmhouse, the bath house, and the barn. The current farm house was built in the late fifties and maintains the classic appearance of the houses built in that era with a large kitchen/dining room which was the heart, soul and meeting place of the whole family in those days and many bedrooms of varying sizes. Another classic part of the architecture of these mid twentieth century farm houses is the large entry way used in the preparation of foods for storage and many other tasks. The exterior is white washed with a bright red roof, keeping in tradition with the color of a most Icelandic farmhouses.

The old farmhouse now serves as our dining area and lounge. All meals are served in our country style kitchen/dining room and prepared by our amazing chef Heimir Hannesson, one of Icelands premier chefs. The focus is on local products such as organic lamb and fresh fish, with great emphasis on using what nature provides in the region. Vegetarians and guests with special dietary requests need not worry for Heimir is well versed in preparing meals for all types of diets. The dining room is well stocked with a selection of locally brewed beer, spirits and wine. You can visit our [Dining](#) page for details on the food you can expect during your stay with us.

We ski right to of the door of Klængshóll Lodge with one of our signature runs 'The Horse' giving you over 1200m or 4000ft of vertical descent right back to the front door of your private cabin.

THE CABINS

Guests will enjoy the luxury of our new traditional style cabins for sleeping. Each cabin is made up of 2 separate "apartments" and all apartments have mountain views. Each apartment has an upper loft with a double bed and a single bed on the main floor so a couple can sleep upstairs or one guest can sleep upstairs and one downstairs for maximum comfort and privacy. Each room has a bathroom with a shower and all the comforts of a remote heli ski lodge, with the added bonus of being very traditional in style, where every detail has been thought out to make your stay as comfortable and memorable as possible. The 4 cabins at Klængshóll comfortably sleep up to 16 guests.



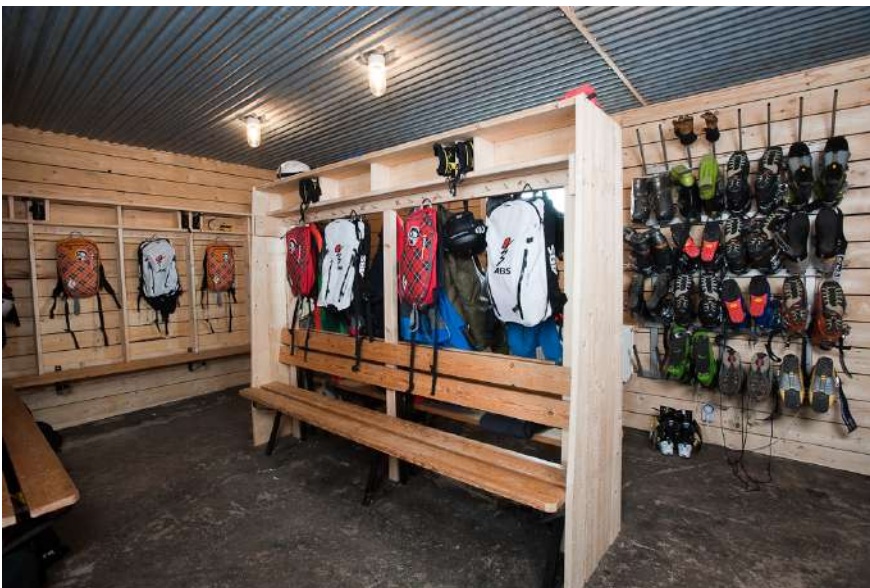
WELLNESS AREA

THE BARN

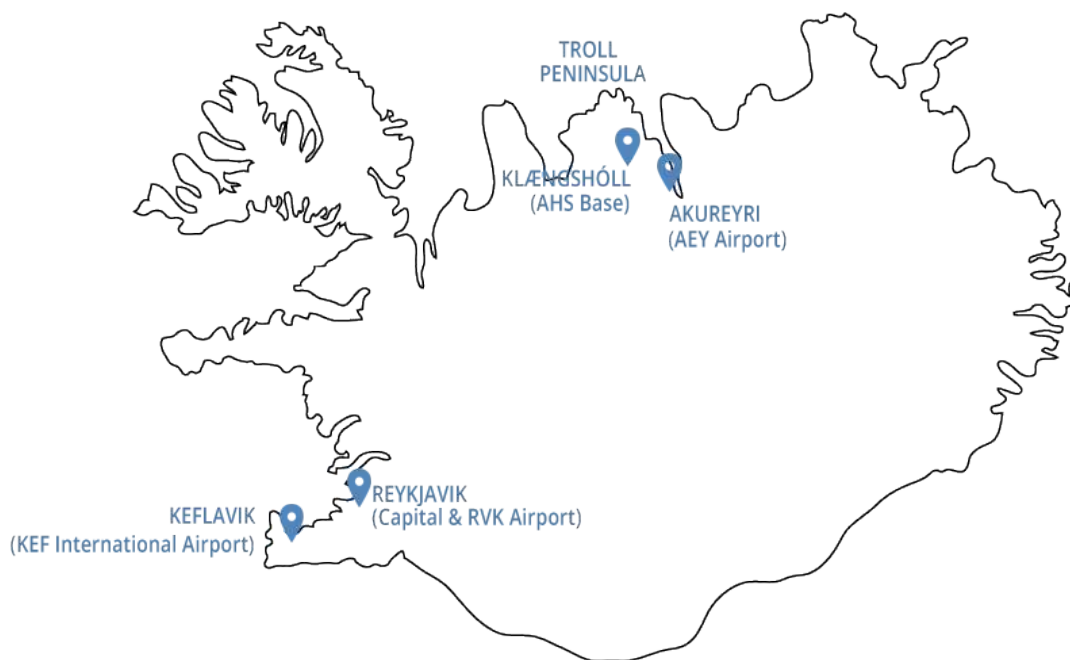
Perhaps no place at Klængshóll is as important or popular as the Barn, which used to hold the winters supply of hay, but has now been restored to house our ski and boot room, ski shop, where our ski techs prepare your skis as well as our very own gift shop. The Barn is also where you will enjoy your apré ski snacks and cold drinks at the end of the day, hanging out by the wood burning stove in the comfortable yet rustic lounge, where you can also enjoy your photos and videos on the big screen or play a round of darts or pool. On the second floor you will find our exercise and Yoga room where guests can enjoy an AM stretch class each morning or go for a few rounds of ping pong at night.



GETTING HERE

Our base of operations is in the north of Iceland just 55 minutes north of Akureyri and outside the town of Dalvík. All International flights arrive at Keflavik in the south of Iceland. This is 45 minutes outside of Iceland's capital, Reykjavik. The Troll Peninsula in the north where we are based is approximately 5 hours from Reykjavik by car or 35 minutes via domestic flight.

With our programs the first day is the arrival day and we ask guests to arrive at Akureyri in the evening. A group dinner is served at the lodge upon arrival. We provide the transfer from Akureyri to the the lodge (approximately 50 minutes). On the final day of the program we recommend that guests take an evening flight out of Akureyri so that they can get the most out of skiing or riding on that day.



FLYING TO ICELAND

There are over a 100 direct flights from Western Europe, the USA and Canada to Iceland every day operated by 25 different airlines. It takes about 2-3 hours to fly from Europe, approximately 5 hours from the East Coast of North America and only 7 hours from the West Coast of North America. There is one main carrier, Icelandair, which services destinations on both sides of the Atlantic. Other airlines servicing Iceland include Play, Easy Jet, Delta Airlines, SAS and British Airways. All flights arrive at Keflavik International Airport, 45 minutes from Reykjavik, Iceland's capital.

DIRECT FLIGHT FROM THE UK TO AKUREYRI

[Easyjet](#) will continue with flights directly into Akureyri Airport from London Gatwick and Manchester on select days in March and April. See our [Custom Dates](#) for offers.

Private jets and charters can land at [Akureyri airport \(AEY\)](#) in the North, only 45 min away from our Lodge by car. Getting to us has never been this easy.

DOMESTIC FLIGHTS

Once you land in Keflavík if you wish to take a flight to our base in the north there are several options.

ICELANDAIR FLIGHTS FROM REYKJAVIK TO AKUREYRI

Transfer (approximately 45 minutes) from the Keflavik International Airport (KEF) to the Reykjavik Domestic Airport (RKV) to take a 35 minute flight to Akureyri (AEY). Please note that the domestic airline servicing Akureyri is [IcelandAir](#) (IcelandAir took over AirIceland Connect in March of 2021).

For flights between Reykjavik (RKV) and Akureyri we recommended the following itinerary with [Icelandair](#):

ARRIVAL DAY: FI50 departing Reykjavik around 18:00 (IcelandAir may have a different flight, however it should be the last departure of the day). If you chose to take an earlier flight to Akureyri you may have to wait in Akureyri for the evening transfer as we have limited resources for additional transfers.

DEPARTURE DAY: FI51 departing Akureyri around 19:00 (on the last day we will stop skiing 2.5 hour prior to the departure time which will allow time to transfer everyone to Akureyri for the evening departure).
